






### **Community Events**

### **Food Projects**


- Our first training session for VCS organisations in the Hackney Food Network took place on Tuesday. The training covered food hygeine and health and safety. This is the first in a series of training sessions we are delivering to build capacity in the Food Network.
- In October Redmond Centre staff issued 12 vouchers for Hackney Foodbank.
- Our other food projects supporting asylum seekers and distributing fresh food to residents are going well.




#### SUMMARY



- These charts provide data on use of the RCC between July September 2024.
   We host different activities, some of which are open to the public, including church services, prayer meetings, exercise groups and community events.
- The graph at the bottom right illustrates the types of bookings we have at Redmond. Our primary bookings are recurring reservations, which occur weekly or monthly and are offered at a discounted rate.
- Our office space is fully utilized, with three rooms currently booked for the entire month by Hackney Works, Hackney Libraries and Ek Outreach.
   Additionally, we accommodate private events such as weddings, birthday parties and baby showers.
