Food Projects

- Delivered 3 days of Kitchen Social during October half term, providing 23 meals for children and parents plus free activities including pumpkin decorating.
- In November to date, Redmond Centre staff have issued 13 vouchers for Hackney Foodbank.
- Our tri-weekly food distribution projects A Taste of Home and Community Fridge are continuing well. Since October's WDCO meeting we have distributed over 1500kg of fresh food to local residents.

- Our 8 week mindful photography course with Mindful Photo Lab has been very well attended. An exhibition of participants work will be displayed at the Redmond Centre from 15th November until 20th December.
- The Redmond Centre has been selected as one of three venues across London to pilot how community spaces can act as hubs to support community responses to emergency events e.g. extreme weather
- Neighbourhoods: the Woodberry Wetlands action group are holding a focus group for young people (16-19 years old) in December to gather insight on barriers to accessing sexual health services. We will also have the sexual health team at the event giving out free condoms and advice. The insights gathered will be passed to the appropriate teams and fed into the City & Hackney Sexual Health Strategy.

SUMMARY



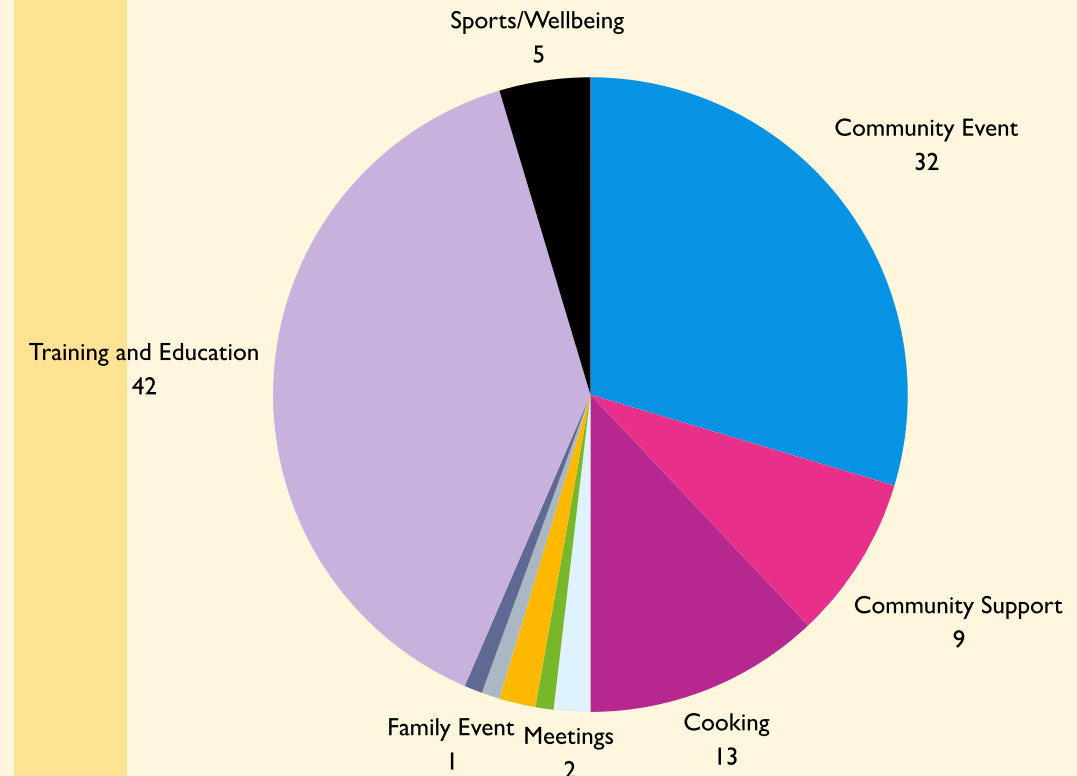
- These charts provide data on use of the RCC between 15th October - 14th November 2024. We host different activities, some of which are open to the public, including church services, prayer meetings, exercise groups and community events.
- The graph at the bottom right illustrates the types of bookings we have at Redmond. Our primary bookings are recurring reservations, which occur weekly or monthly and are offered at a discounted rate.
- Our office space is fully utilized, with three rooms currently booked for the entire month by Hackney Works, Hackney Libraries and Ek Outreach. Additionally, we accommodate private events such as weddings, birthday parties and baby showers.



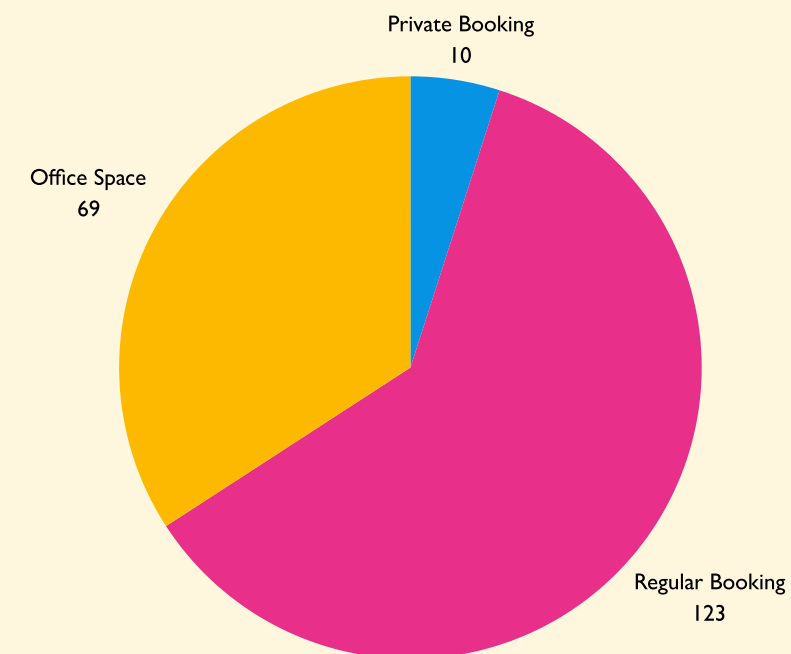
TRAFFIC (TOTAL ATTENDEES)

CENTRE USE BY ACTIVITY



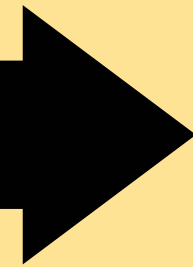
CENTRE USE BY BOOKING TYPE





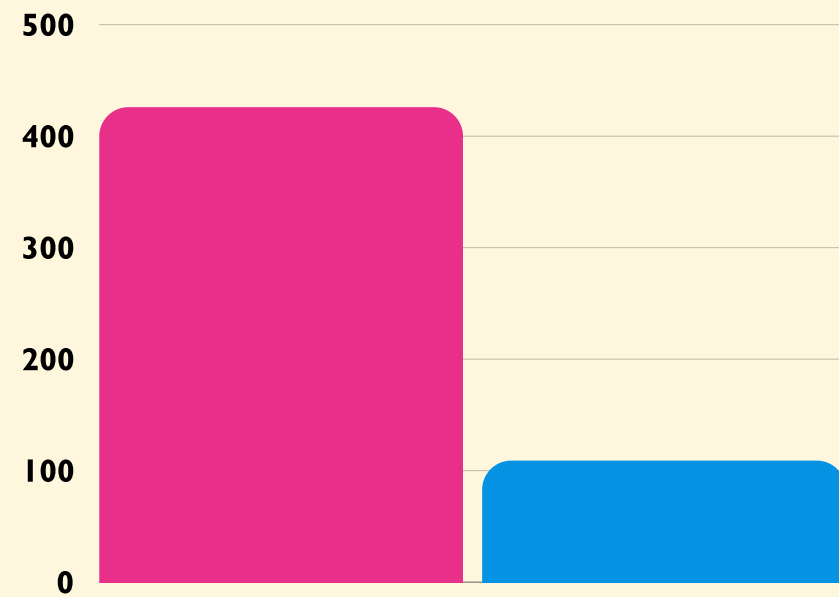

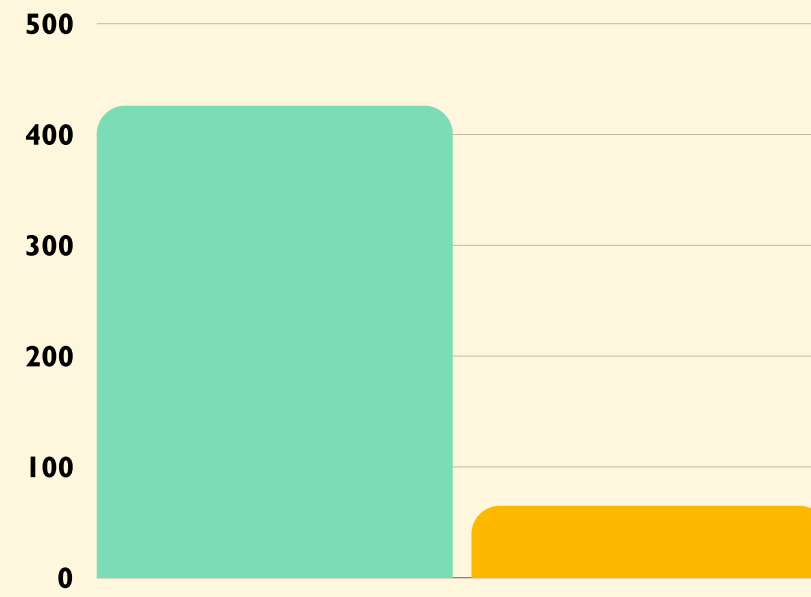

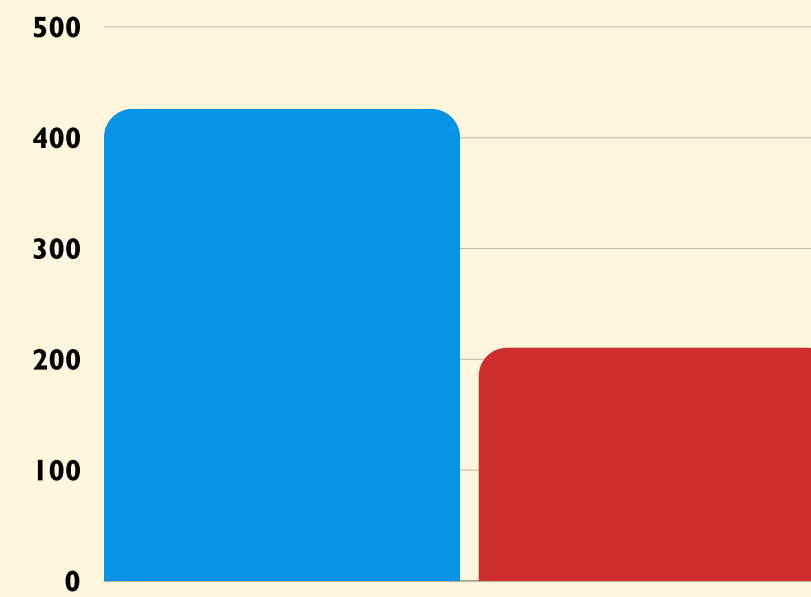
ROOM ONE

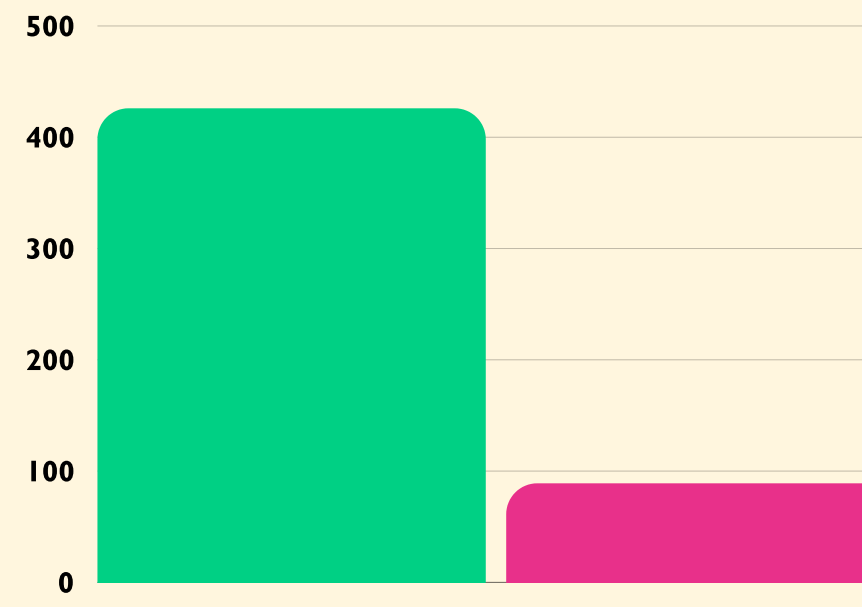
