WDCO now receives three separate documents from NHG – the development report, the P&E update, and the workstream table. This enables fine-grained provision of information for which we are grateful. – I have sent a separate update the last two months due to work schedule but will continue to include the P&E update on the wider NHG report going forward, with the addition of the workstream report.

Residents' Associations

Is there any feedback from the Residents Association round table held recently? Did any representatives from Woodberry Down attend? I sent a summary of feedback yesterday, unfortunately no WDCO reps or WD residents attended. I contacted Deji and asked him to contact the current informal RA's. He advises he has done this via Roda but will try again.

Following a meeting held in February of this year a number of actions were set out for example:

NHG's Resident Involvement team will contact the current informal RA groups directly, Jada will share their email addresses once provided by Roda.

Has progress been made on this and the other actions agreed?

Insite remote meter reading.

Is the problem reported in this month's update the same problem that was reported by email on February 24th and which can apparently be resolved by the installation of a new SIM card? Further update as of yesterday afternoon: The contractor attended site to replace the SIM as previously advised. Unfortunately, they have now confirmed that the existing router is not compatible with any available SIM cards and will need to be fully replaced. The unit appears to be an older model for which compatible SIMs are no longer obtainable.

Laura has asked the contractor whether it would be possible to temporarily repurpose a router from one of the other blocks so we can begin capturing readings in the interim. We have not yet received a response to this request, so she will follow up again to confirm whether this is a viable temporary solution. I have requested timelines and will follow up with these.

London School of Architecture's RC/YCC.

The same report has been supplied under this heading for three successive months. In next month's report please can we have some indication of when we expect there to be progress under this heading.
