- In July and August we distributed just over 2,024,850kg of fresh food through Community Fridge, issued 20 Hackney Foodbank vouchers, and supported asylum seekers to cook 220 meals.
- We continue to support residents with ensuring they are claiming all the benefits they are entitled to, signposting and referrals to local services during our weekly community fridge.
- Weekly free mindfulness sessions ran until the end of July and are taking a break over the summer. They are re-starting on 7<sup>th</sup> September. To book a place please email [mindful.hackney@gmail.com](mailto:mindful.hackney@gmail.com).
- The summer fun-day was a great day with henna, cargo-bike trials, free fitness sessions
- We delivered six weekly Kitchen Social sessions over the summer for local children aged 6 to 11. A total of 15 young people took part, building their confidence and creativity while enjoying a nutritious two-course lunch at each session. As a culmination of the programme, participants will showcase their work at the Hidden River Festival through a caterpillar parade. The theme of the sessions explored the past, present and future of Woodberry Down, alongside its rich ecology and wildlife.
- Recruitment opened during July for the Project Coordinator role with interviews conducted in August. The role is a day and a half a week to support the project manager.

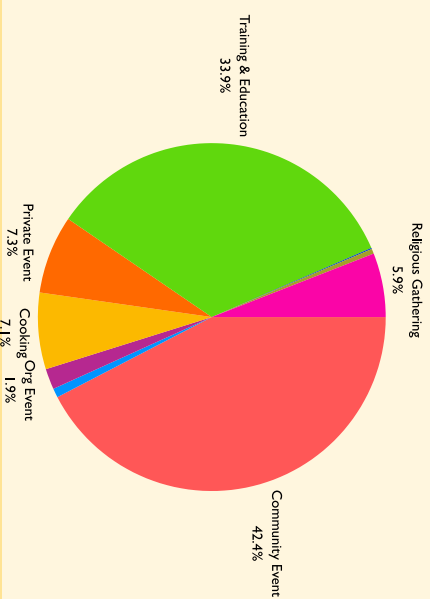
## SUMMARY

- These charts provide data on use of the RCC for the month of July and August 2026. We host different activities, some of which are open to the public, including church services, prayer meetings, exercise groups and community events. Community event represents events that are open to the public for free or at low cost eg: church, youth group, vegetable collection, music class etc.
- The graph at the bottom right illustrates the percentage of the booking type we have at Redmond. Our primary bookings are regular reservations, which occur weekly or monthly and are offered at a discounted rate. LDT Funded bookings will be termed as booking that are funded fully or partially by LDT and no/little hiring fee has been charged for these bookings. We have a new regular booking that aims are supporting SEND kids. They rent Room1 on every weekday of the month.
- Our office space is fully utilized, with three rooms currently booked on a monthly basis by Hackney Works, Hackney Libraries and Ek Outreach (shown as office space in the Chart). Additionally, we accommodate private and community events, which may or may not be LDT funded.

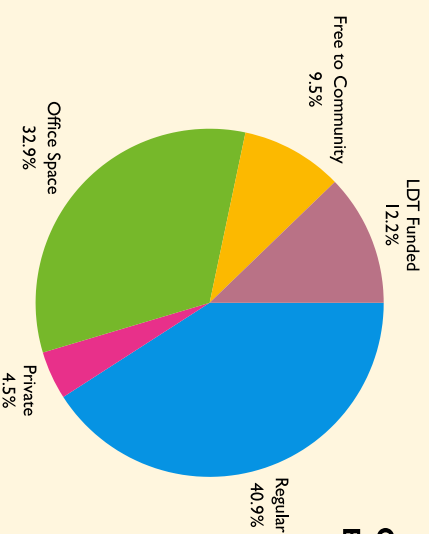


**TRAFFIC (TOTAL ATTENDEES)**

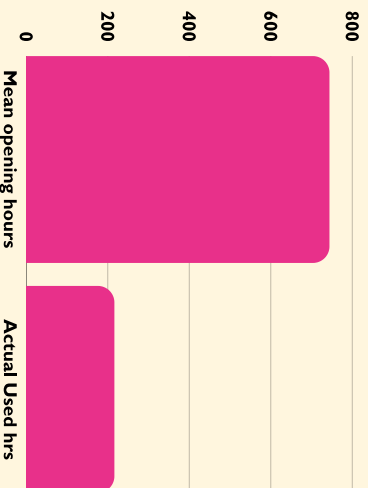

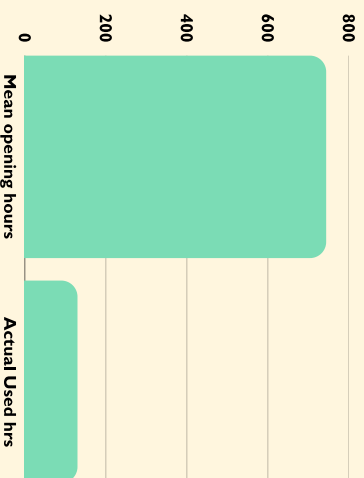

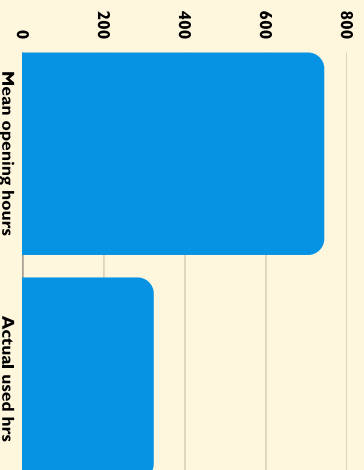

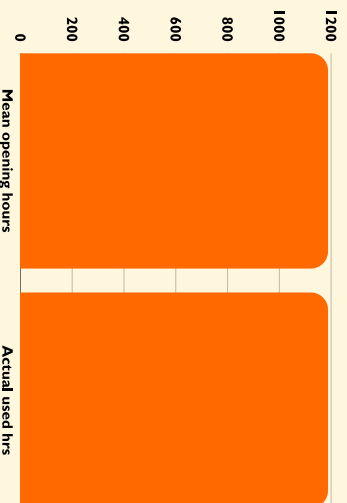

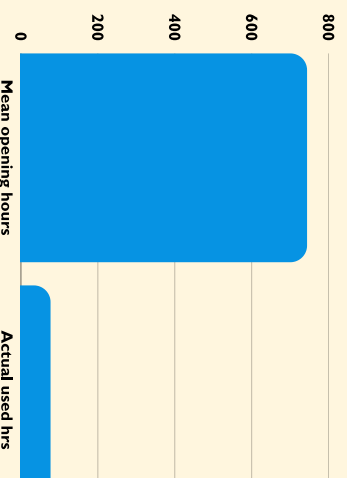

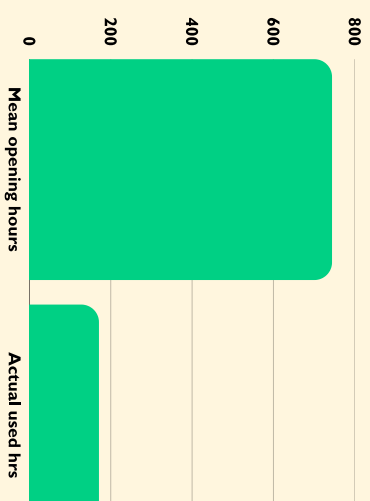

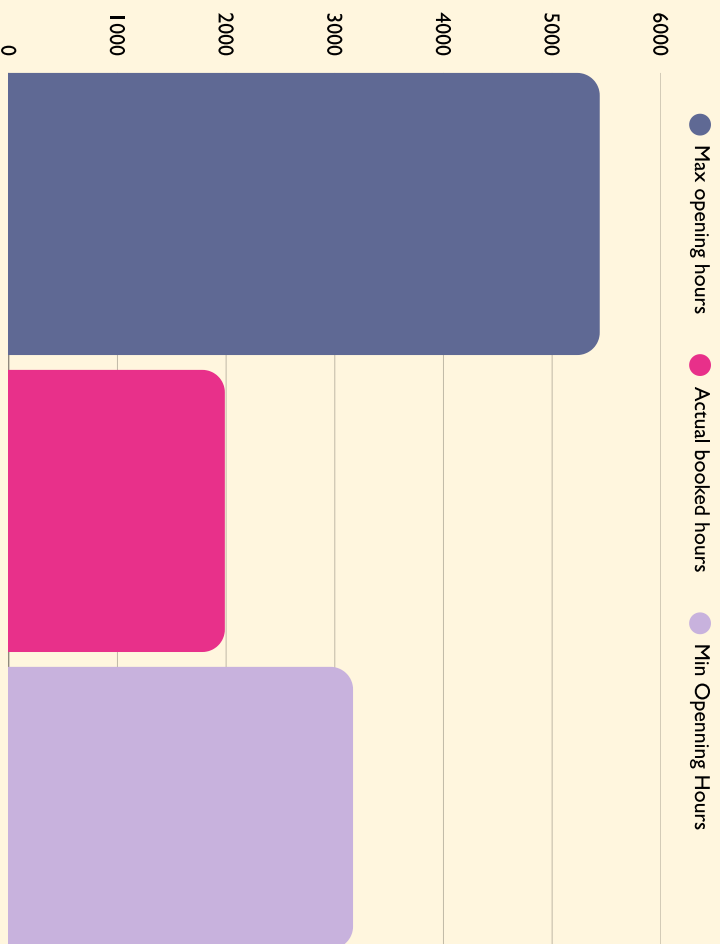
